Limitations and alternatives

Known limitations for Smarthub:

1. There are a few administration tools within Smarthub that do not entity conform to accessibility standards due to their complexity.

The use of a mouse to engage with the tool, no keyboard alternative because the way the interface is designed and operates for this specific requirement.

We have lots of alternative tools to utilise in place of the tools that do not incorporate accessibility options; this does not affect non-admin users.

Admins can utilise other tools that are accessibility optimised to under the same tasks.
